WALLS



Wipe down walls with a damp cloth to ensure they are clean and free of dust. Allow to dry.



Tape around the vanity frame and countertop edges with painter's tape to ensure you don't get primer or paint where you don't want it!



To ensure a mildew resistant primer coat, apply 1 coat of KILZ® Kitchen & Bath (stirring thoroughly before and occasionally during use) to the walls and allow to dry. Apply primer using a brush first to "cut in" around the edges, then use a roller to fill in.



Once primer is dry, apply KILZ Complete Coat® in White using the same application method as the primer (using a brush first to cut in around the edges 4 to 6 feet at a time, then use a roller to fill in those sections before moving along).



5 Remove the tape before the paint is fully dry.
