Depending on the vision you have for the project, simply apply 1 or 2 coats on a clean, dust-free, or lightly sanded surface. For interior use only. Do not use in high-humidity environments. To enhance durability, seal the surface afterward with KILZ CLEAR SEALING WAX. An "antique" look can be achieved by applying two contrasting colors, distressing with sandpaper, and sealing with KILZ DARK SEALING WAX.

APPLICATION

Note: This product is formulated to be rich and concentrated to provide excellent hide and coverage. If you find this product to be too thick, add up to 2 oz. of water per quart to thin it to the desired thickness for smooth and easy application.

DRY TIME @ 77°F and 50% RH:

To Touch: 1 hour To Recoat: 2 hours

Darker colors may require additional dry time between coats. Cooler temperatures or higher humidity may prolong drying time.

SURFACE PREPARATION

- Before applying KILZ CHALK STYLE PAINT, clean the surface to make sure it is free of loose or peeling paint, mold and mildew stains, rust and other dirt and debris.
- We recommend lightly sanding glossy surfaces and repairing any imperfections.
- Remove all dust with a damp cloth and allow to dry. Use KILZ CHALK STYLE PAINT on properly prepared uncoated or painted interior surfaces.
- For wood that contains tannins, such as Redwood and Cedar, a coat of primer such as KILZ PREMIUM Interior/Exterior waterbased primer is recommended

Glossy Surfaces:

- †For optimal adhesion to difficult surfaces, use KILZ PREMIUM Primer
- Follow the instructions on the back of the primer label and top coat it with KILZ CHALK STYLE PAINT

New Wood:

WARNING! Sanding or scraping pressure treated lumber may be hazardous; wear appropriate protection. Remove mill glaze with sandpaper. Set nails and fill holes, scratches, and gouges with the appropriate wood filler and let dry completely. Remove all dust with a wiping cloth. Fill all gaps with a paintable caulking, and allow to completely dry prior to coating.

WARNING! If you scrape, sand or remove old paint, you may release lead dust. **LEAD IS TOXIC.** Contact the National Lead Information Center at 1-800-424-LEAD or visit www.epa.gov/lead.

CLEAN UP & DISPOSAL

Clean all tools and equipment with water. For disposal of empty containers and unused product, contact your household refuse collection service.
